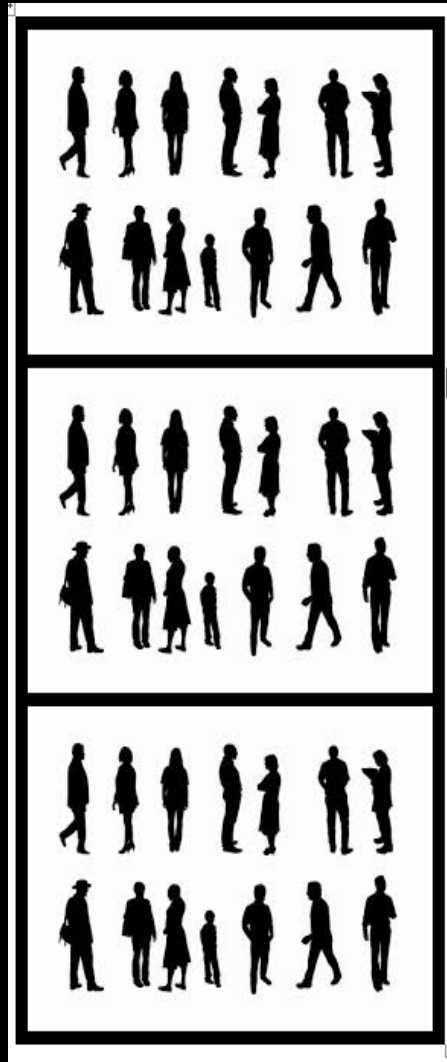

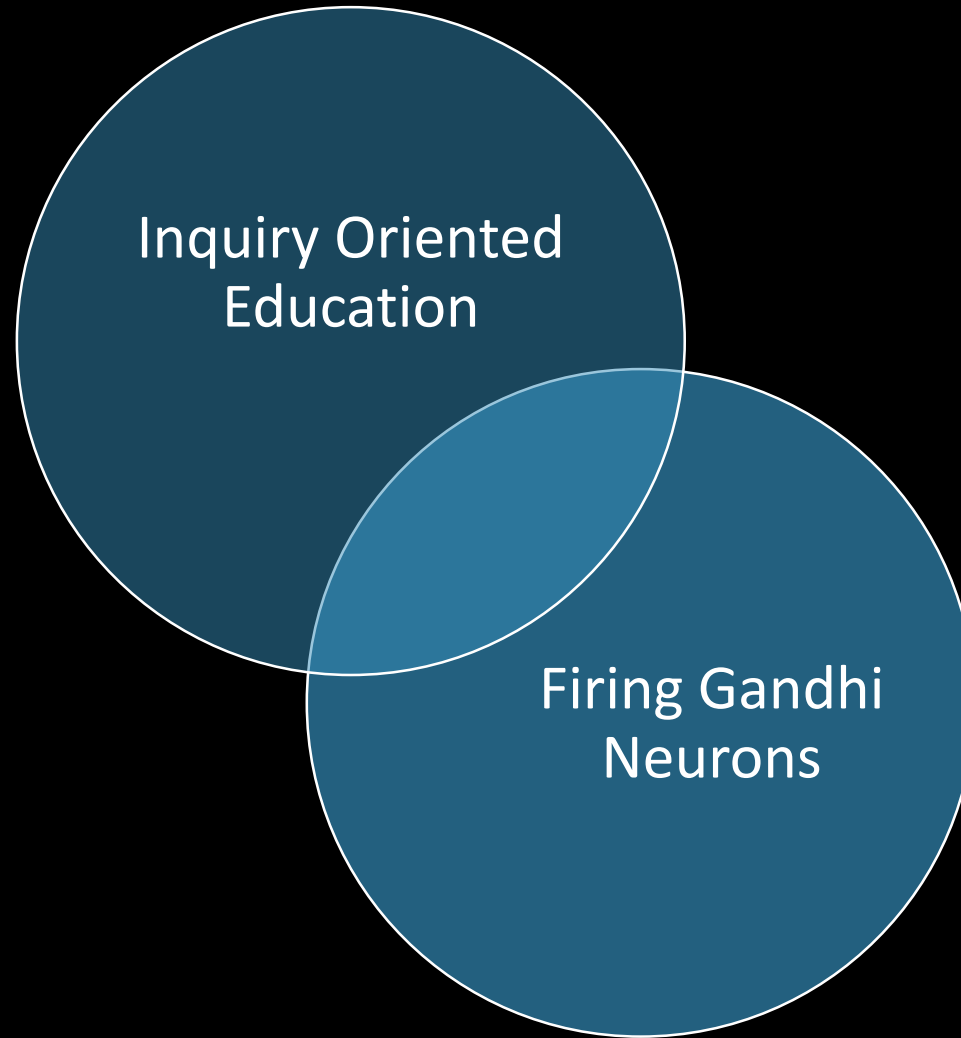
Moderate exposure
to peace education

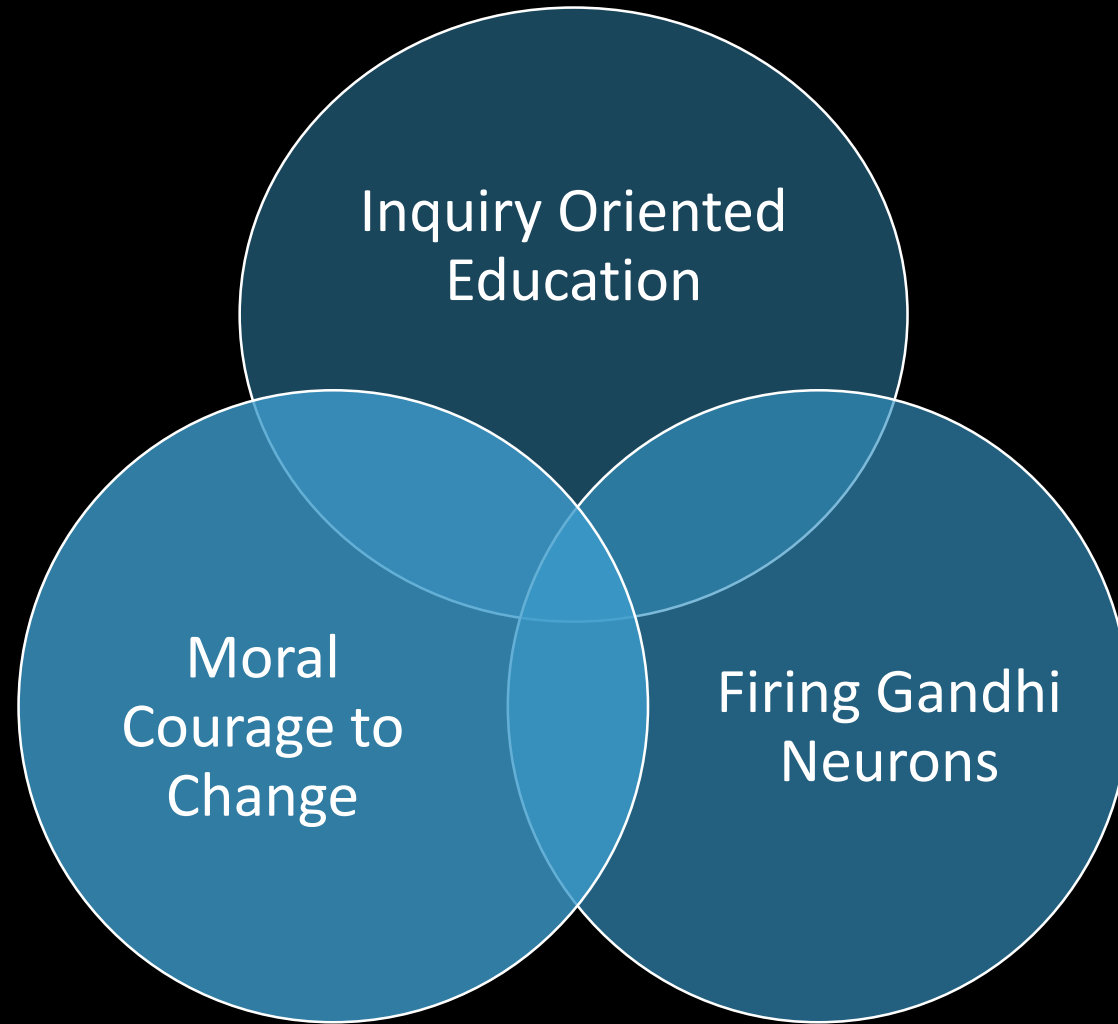
High exposure to
peace education

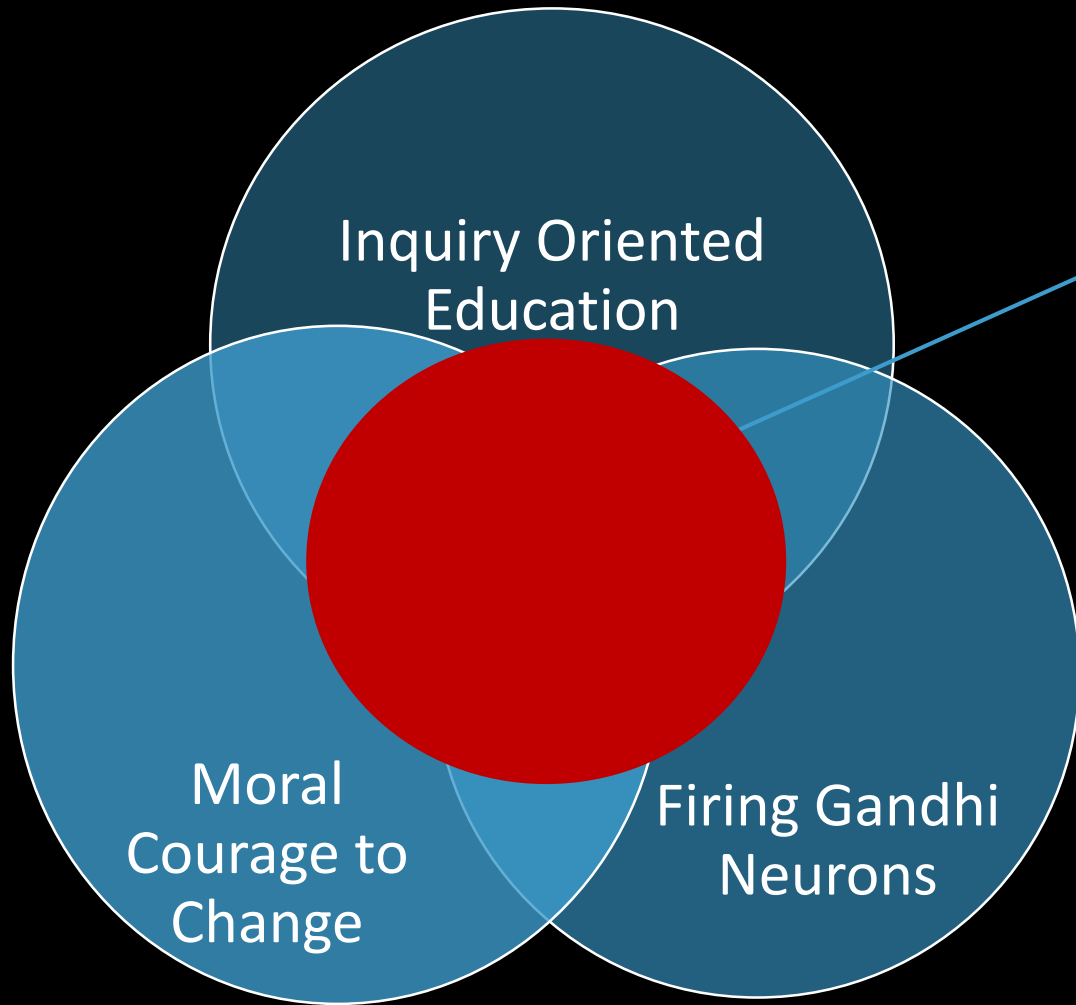
No correlation between
